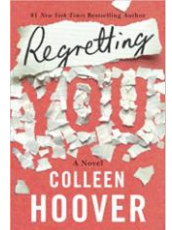
Book Spotlight

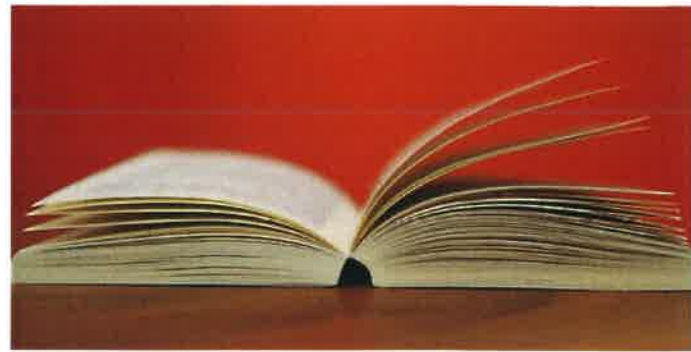
