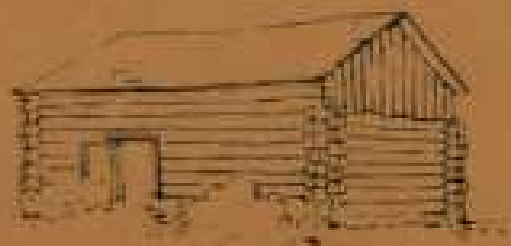
Hannah Brooks (the bodyguard) is hired to protect superstar actor Jack Stapleton.

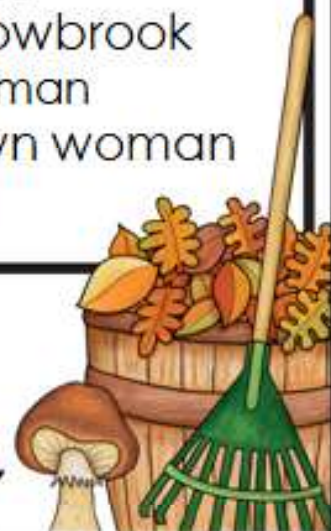

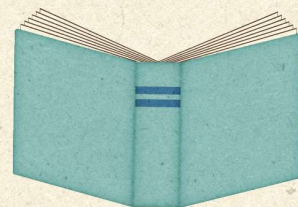
